Costs for 'day only' and overnight events

Groups using the camp for overnight events & having at least half the total group staying overnight in the cabins/lodge, will have the *primary* conference space fee waived. Additional meeting space will be provided upon request/subject to availability.

NOTE:

- An Activity Fee of \$ 2.00 per person/per day will be charged for all persons enjoying the use of the facility but not staying overnight on site.
- Conference spaces are generally closed by midnight. Groups may extend use beyond midnight for an additional fee of 25.00. Please make prior arrangements with the office.
- The gate is closed from midnight – 6 am. If you need access to the gate during these times, please make arrangements prior with the office.

### Meals/Dining Hall Services

**Bethany Camp & Conference Center** will provide meals and kitchen personnel for all events, providing that your group meets the minimum requirement of 30 diners. No person or group, other than **Bethany Camp & Conference Center** certified personnel, will be allowed the use of the kitchen facility, located in the Dining Hall.

- Banquets will be charged at a cost of \$25.00/person for a standard menu, with no additional charges for conference space. We do require a minimum of 40 meals paid.
- Please connect with our Guest Experience Director to discuss your event (Room arrangement, costs, menu, etc... )
- The deposit for a banquet is half the total.
- Special menus available. The meal cost will be contingent upon current market cost of requested foods.
- Groups/Organizations will be responsible for the number of advance reservations, plus any additional persons attending.
